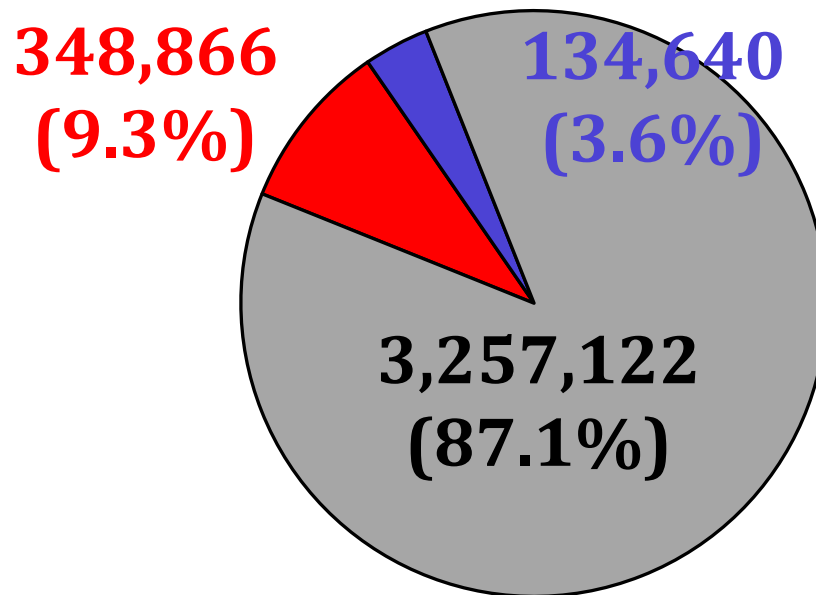
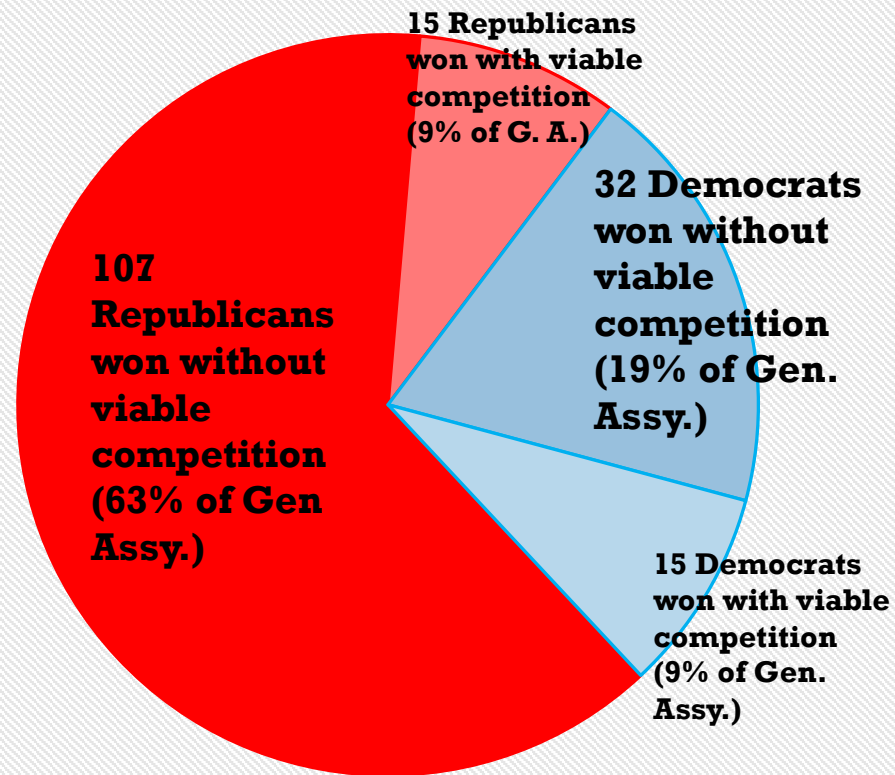


2024 S.C. PRIMARY VOTER PARTICIPATION

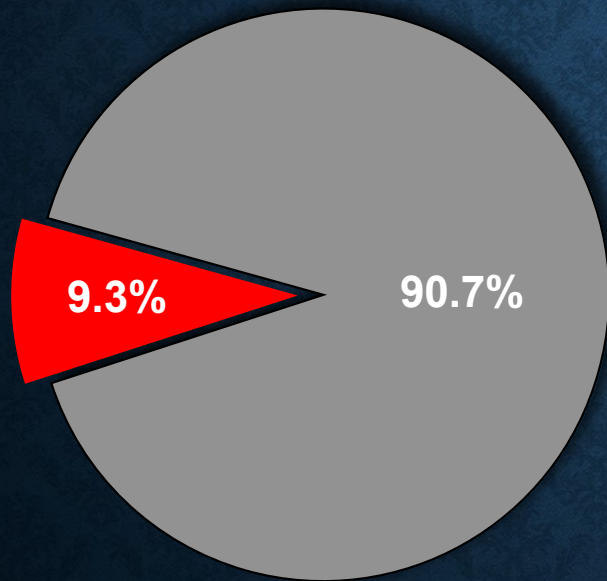


- Registered voters who voted in Republican primary

WHO HAD VIABLE COMPETITION IN S.C. LEGISLATIVE RACES?

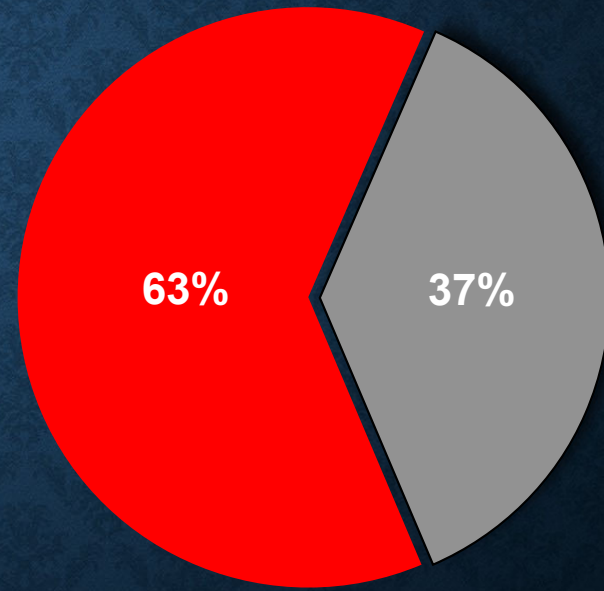

Republican Primary**

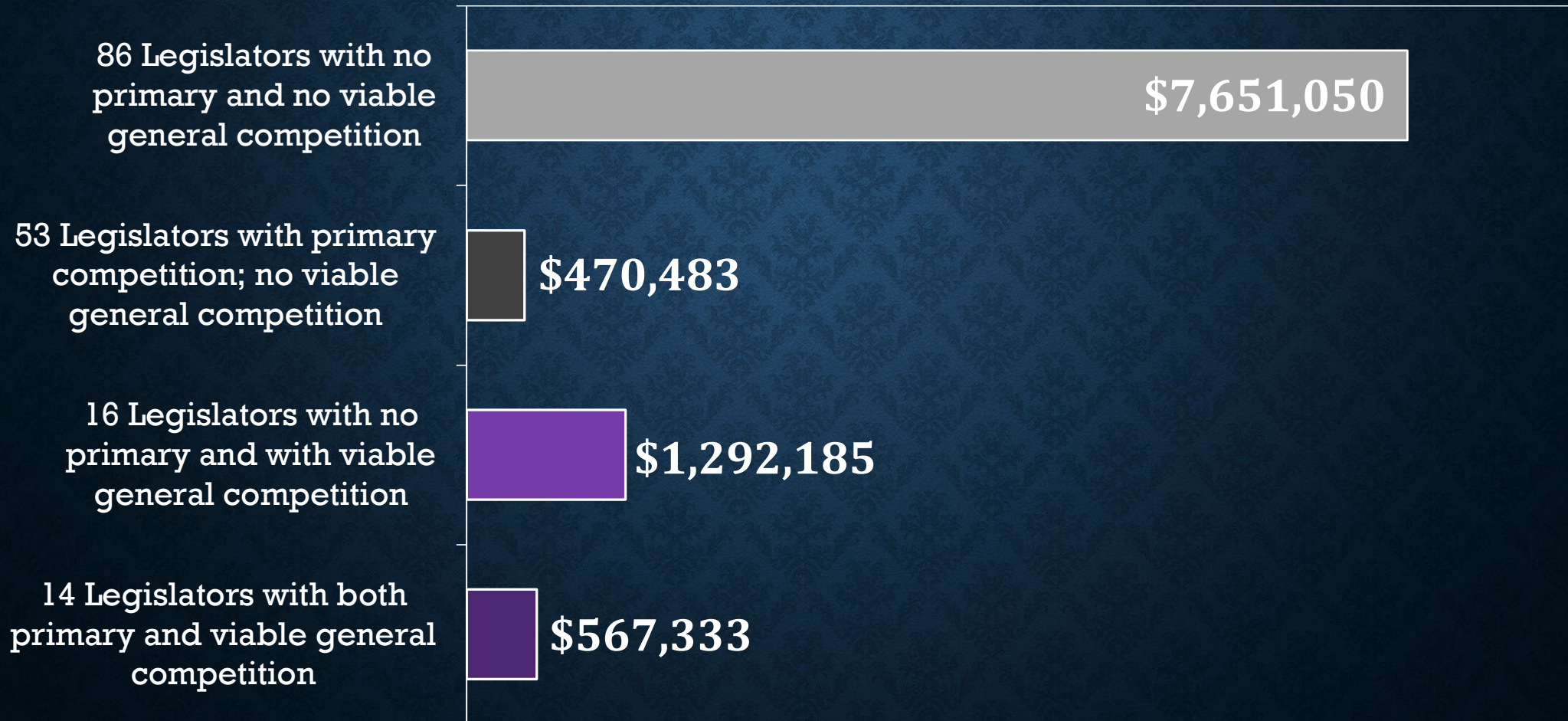

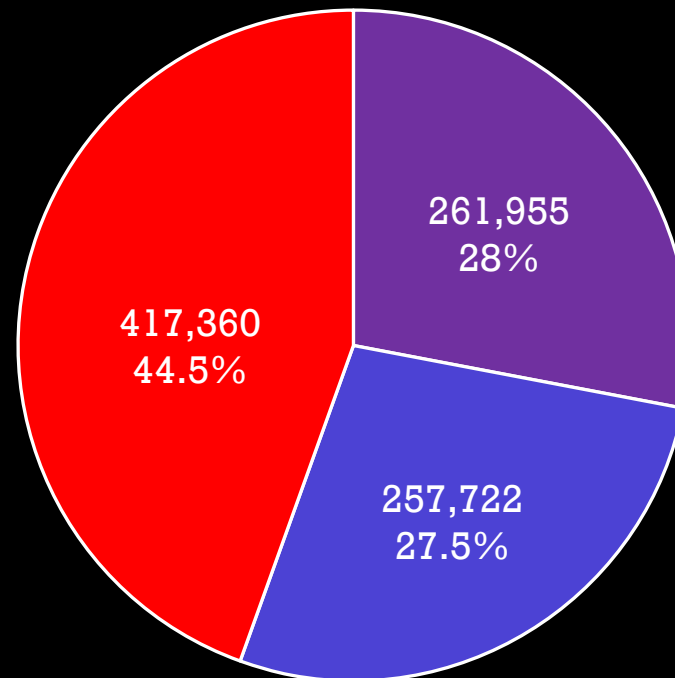

MONEY RAISED BY S.C. STATE LEGISLATORS IN 2024



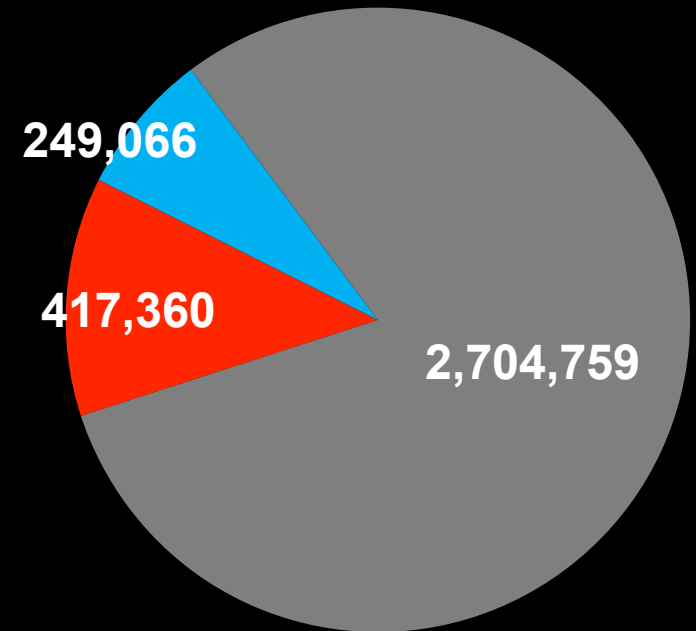
2024 S.C. SENATE GENERAL ELECTION: – *NONWHITE VOTER OPTIONS* –



- 44.5% of non-white voters with only a white Republican who had no viable competition
- 27.5% of non-white voters with only a Democrat who had no viable competition
- 28% of non-white voters with two viable candidates on their ballot

2024 S.C. SENATE GENERAL ELECTION: – *NONWHITE AND WHITE VOTER OPTIONS* –

- 417,360 non-white voters only had a white Republican with no viable comp
- 249,066 white voters only had a Black Democrat with no viable comp
- 2,704,759... the rest of the voters
