I	Independent: an individual not affiliated with a political party. A.K.A.: <i>non-party</i>, <i>unenrolled</i>, and <i>unaffiliated</i>. In some cases, an independent candidate may associate in some way with a political party (for example, as a voter in a party's primary elections) but opt not to run under that party's label.
L	Libertarian Party
Non-partisan	Generally, describe a group or individual that does not expressly support one political party or candidate over another.
